OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for a wellhead treatment facility
1.3 in the city of Dayton; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **DAYTON; WATER TREATMENT FACILITY.**

1.6 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$5,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.7 to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to the city of Dayton to predesign, design, and
1.8 construct a wellhead treatment facility in the Historic Village neighborhood in the northwest
1.9 portion of the city of Dayton to address high levels of manganese and iron in the city water
1.10 supply.

1.11 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.12 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.13 the state in an amount up to \$5,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.14 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.15 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
