- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to local government; prohibiting municipal identification cards for
- 1.3 undocumented immigrants; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,
- 1.4 chapter 415.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. **[415.21] MUNICIPAL IDS.**
- 1.7 Subdivision 1. **Definitions.** (a) The terms defined in this subdivision apply to this section.
- 1.8 (b) "Municipality" means a home rule charter or statutory city.
- 1.9 (c) "Municipal ID" means an identification card in physical or electronic form created
- 1.10 and provided by a municipality to a resident of the municipality that includes the individual's
- 1.11 name and address and any other identifying information.
- 1.12 (d) "Undocumented immigrant" means a noncitizen who resides in the United States
- 1.13 without the approval or acquiescence of the Immigration and Naturalization Service of the
- 1.14 United States Department of Justice.
- 1.15 Subd. 2. **Prohibition.** A municipality must not provide a municipal ID to an
- 1.16 undocumented immigrant.
- 1.17 Subd. 3. **Certain previously issued municipal IDs invalid.** A municipal ID issued to
- 1.18 an undocumented immigrant before the effective date of this section is not valid for any
- 1.19 purpose.
