1.5	Section 1. WILD RICE WATER QUALITY STANDARDS.
1.6	(a) Until the commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency adopts the rules required

- 1.7 <u>under Laws 2011, First Special Session chapter 2, article 4, section 32, designating waters</u>
- 1.8 containing natural beds of wild rice that are subject to wild rice water quality standards,
- 1.9 <u>the commissioner shall not:</u>
- 1.10 (1) apply the wild rice water quality standard for sulfate in class 4A waters to any
- 1.11 waters, including incorporating the standard or any requirements based on the standard
- 1.12 within any permits, compliance schedules, orders, or other control documents; or
