A bill for an act
relating to liquor; authorizing on-sale liquor license for private, nonprofit college with certain conditions; amending Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 340A.404, by adding a subdivision.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 340A.404, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

Subd. 14. Private college. Notwithstanding any other law, local ordinance, or charter provision, the governing body of a municipality may issue an on-sale intoxicating $\underline{\text { liquor license to a private, nonprofit college located within the municipality, or to any }}$ entity holding a caterer's permit and a contract with the private, nonprofit college for catering on the premises of the private, nonprofit college, or for any portion of the premises as described in the approved license application. The license authorized by this subdivision may be issued for space that is not compact and contiguous, provided that all such space is included in the description of the licensed premises on the approved license application. The license authorizes sales on all days of the week to persons attending events at the private, nonprofit college. All other provisions of this chapter not inconsistent with this section apply to the license authorized under this section.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
