OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to local government; designating certain areas of the city of Oak Grove
1.3 as rural residential for the purposes of the comprehensive plan update.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **OAK GROVE; COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.**

1.6 Subdivision 1. Oak Grove. Notwithstanding any law, metropolitan system plan, the
1.7 2015 system statement for the city of Oak Grove, or administrative law judge's decision to
1.8 the contrary, the area of the city that was the subject of the administrative law judge's decision
1.9 in OAH 5-2106-33226, dated May 10, 2016, is designated "rural residential" for the purposes
1.10 of the city's comprehensive plan update.

1.11 Subd. 2. Metropolitan Council. The Metropolitan Council shall conform its metropolitan
1.12 development guide, system plans, and the system statement for the city of Oak Grove to
1.13 accommodate the provisions in subdivision 1.

1.14 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day after the governing body of the
1.15 city of Oak Grove and its chief clerical officer timely complete their compliance with
1.16 Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021, subdivisions 2 and 3. This section applies in the counties
1.17 of Anoka, Carver, Dakota, Hennepin, Ramsey, Scott, and Washington.
