1.1 A bill for an act
 1.2 relating to motor vehicles; establishing retired law enforcement special license
 1.3 plates; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 168.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **[168.1256] SPECIAL RETIRED LAW ENFORCEMENT PLATES.**

1.6 Subdivision 1. **Issuance of plates.** The commissioner shall issue special retired law
 1.7 enforcement license plates or a single motorcycle plate to an applicant who:

1.8 (1) is a registered owner of a passenger automobile, noncommercial one-ton pickup
 1.9 truck, motorcycle, or recreational vehicle;

1.10 (2) is a retired peace officer as defined in section 626.84, subdivision 1, paragraphs (c)
 1.11 or (d);

1.12 (3) provides a letter from the chief law enforcement officer affirming that the applicant
 1.13 is a retired peace officer who served ten or more years and separated in good standing;

1.14 (4) pays a fee of \$10 for each set of plates, along with any other fees required by this
 1.15 chapter;

1.16 (5) pays the registration tax as required under section 168.013; and

1.17 (6) complies with this chapter and rules governing registration of motor vehicles and
 1.18 licensing of drivers.

1.19 Subd. 2. **Design.** The commissioner shall design an emblem and inscription for the
 1.20 special plates, in consultation with interested law enforcement agencies and organizations.

2.1 Subd. 3. **Plates transfer.** On application to the commissioner and payment of a transfer
2.2 fee of \$5, special plates issued under this section may be transferred to another motor vehicle
2.3 if the subsequent vehicle is:

2.4 (1) qualified under subdivision 1, clause (1), to bear the special plates; and

2.5 (2) registered to the same individual to whom the special plates were originally issued.

2.6 Subd. 4. **Exemption.** Special plates issued under this section are not subject to section
2.7 168.1293, subdivision 2.

2.8 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2018, for special retired law
2.9 enforcement plates issued on or after that date.
