- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 326B.101, is amended to read:
- 1.6 **326B.101 POLICY AND PURPOSE.**
- 1.7 The State Building Code governs the construction, reconstruction, alteration, repair, and
- 1.8 use of buildings and other structures to which the code is applicable. The commissioner
- 1.9 ~~shall~~ must administer and amend a state code of building construction which will provide
- 1.10 basic and uniform performance standards, establish reasonable safeguards for health, safety,
- 1.11 welfare, comfort, and security of the residents of this state and provide for the use of modern
- 1.12 methods, devices, materials, and techniques which will in part tend to lower construction
- 1.13 costs. The construction of buildings should be permitted at the least possible cost consistent
- 1.14 with recognized standards of health and safety.
