1.6	Section 1. SECRETARY OF STATE; REIMBURSEMENT TO GENERAL FUND

1.8	To implement the repealer provided in section 2, the secretary of state must reimburse
1.9	the general fund for any amounts that were not canceled to the general fund at the end of

Sec. 39. <u>APPROPRIATION; SECRETARY OF STATE; COURT ORDERED ATTORNEY</u> <u>FEES.</u>

\$1,290,000 is appropriated in fiscal year 2019 from the general fund to the secretary of state for the payment of attorney fees awarded by court order in *Minnesota Voters Alliance v. Mansky*. This is a onetime appropriation.
