1.8	Section 1. [16C.0851] WAIVER; WASTE CONTRACTS; VEHICLE
1.9	ACQUISITION PROHIBITED.
1.10	Subdivision 1. Waiver. Notwithstanding section 16C.08, 16C.09, 43A.047, or other
1.11	law to the contrary, the commissioner may enter into or approve a service contract for
1.12	waste removal without determining that no current state employee is able and available to
1.13	perform the services called for by the contract.
1.14	Subd. 2. Capitol complex. The commissioner may not acquire by purchase or lease
1.15	a waste-hauling vehicle for use in the Capitol complex.
1.16	<b>EFFECTIVE DATE.</b> This section is effective the day following final enactment.
