1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 475.58, subdivision 3a, is amended to read:
1.6	Subd. 3a. Youth ice Recreational facilities. A municipality may, without regard to
1.7	the election requirement under subdivision 1 or under any other provision of law or home
1.8	rule charter, issue and sell obligations to refund existing debt of an indoor ice arena finance
1.9	the acquisition, improvement, construction, or renovation of a recreational facility that is
1.10	used predominantly for youth athletic activity if all the following conditions are met:
1.11	(1) the obligations are secured by a pledge of revenues from the facility; and
1.12	(2) the governing body of the municipality finds, based on analysis provided by a
1.13	professional experienced in finance, that the facility's revenues and other available money
1.14	will be sufficient to pay the obligations, without reliance on a an additional property tax
1.15	levy or the municipality's general purpose state aid.
