1.10	An amendment to the Minnesota Constitution is proposed to the people. If the

1.12	Sec. 2. The number of members who compose the senate and house of representatives	
1.13	shall be prescribed by law. The senate shall be comprised of 40 members, and the house	
1.14	of representatives shall be comprised of 80 members. The representation in both houses	
1.15	shall be apportioned equally throughout the different sections of the state in proportion	
1.16	to the population thereof.

2.10	representatives are apportioned throughout the state in 67 senate districts and 134 house of
2.11	representatives districts the number of districts prescribed by the Minnesota Constitution.
2.12	Each senate district is entitled to elect one senator and each house of representatives
2.13	district is entitled to elect one representative.
2.14	Sec. 2. <u>REPEALER.</u>
2.15	Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 2.021, is repealed.
