BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **[641.055] REPORTS OF JAILER INJURIES.**

A sheriff shall furnish to the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension a report for each

1.8

incident that results in a job-related injury to a correctional guard employed by the sheriff.

1.9

By February 1 of each even-numbered year, the commissioner of public safety shall report

1.10

to the chairs and ranking minority members of legislative committees with oversight

1.11

authority over local correctional facilities a summary of information received from sheriffs

1.12

under this section for the two-year period ending the prior December 31.
