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| 1.4        | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:  |
| 1.5        | Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 256B.0625, subdivision 9, is amended to read:  |
| 1.6        | Subd. 9. Dental services. (a) Medical assistance covers dental services.   |
| 1.7        | (b) Medical assistance dental coverage for nonpregnant adults is limited to the following  |
| 1.8        | services:  |
| 1.9        | (1) comprehensive exams, limited to once every five years;   |
| 1.10       | (2) periodic exams, limited to one per year;   |
| 1.11       | (3) limited exams;   |
| 1.12       | (4) bitewing x-rays, limited to one per year;  |
| 1.13       | (5) periapical x-rays;   |
| 1.14       | (6) panoramic x-rays, limited to one every five years except (1) when medically necessary  |
| 1.15       | for the diagnosis and follow-up of oral and maxillofacial pathology and trauma or (2) once   |
| 1.16       | every two years for patients who cannot cooperate for intraoral film due to a developmental  |
| 1.17       | disability or medical condition that does not allow for intraoral film placement;  |
| 1.18       | (7) prophylaxis, limited to one per year;  |
| 1.19       | (8) application of fluoride varnish, limited to one per year;  |
| 1.20       | (9) posterior fillings, all at the amalgam rate;   |

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| 2.1  | (10) anterior fillings;  |
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| 2.2  | (11) endodontics, limited to root canals on the anterior and premolars only;                 |
| 2.3  | (12) removable prostheses, each dental arch limited to one every six years;                  |
| 2.4  | (13) oral surgery, limited to extractions, biopsies, and incision and drainage of abscesses; |
| 2.5  | (14) palliative treatment and sedative fillings for relief of pain;                          |
| 2.6  | (15) full-mouth debridement, limited to one every five years; and                            |
| 2.7  | (16) nonsurgical treatment for periodontal disease, including scaling and root planing       |
| 2.8  | once every two years for each quadrant, and routine periodontal maintenance procedures.      |
| 2.9  | (c) In addition to the services specified in paragraph (b), medical assistance covers the    |
| 2.10 | following services for adults, if provided in an outpatient hospital setting or freestanding |
| 2.11 | ambulatory surgical center as part of outpatient dental surgery:                             |
| 2.12 | (1) periodontics, limited to periodontal scaling and root planing once every two years;      |
| 2.13 | (2) general anesthesia; and  |
| 2.14 | (3) full-mouth survey once every five years.   |
| 2.15 | (d) Medical assistance covers medically necessary dental services for children and           |
| 2.16 | pregnant women. The following guidelines apply:  |
| 2.17 | (1) posterior fillings are paid at the amalgam rate;   |
| 2.18 | (2) application of sealants are covered once every five years per permanent molar for        |
| 2.19 | children only;   |
| 2.20 | (3) application of fluoride varnish is covered once every six months; and                    |
| 2.21 | (4) orthodontia is eligible for coverage for children only.                                  |
| 2.22 | (e) In addition to the services specified in paragraphs (b) and (c), medical assistance      |
| 2.23 | covers the following services for adults:  |
| 2.24 | (1) house calls or extended care facility calls for on-site delivery of covered services;    |
| 2.25 | (2) behavioral management when additional staff time is required to accommodate              |
| 2.26 | behavioral challenges and sedation is not used;  |
| 2.27 | (3) oral or IV sedation, if the covered dental service cannot be performed safely without    |
| 2.28 | it or would otherwise require the service to be performed under general anesthesia in a      |
| 2.29 | hospital or surgical center; and   |

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(4) prophylaxis, in accordance with an appropriate individualized treatment plan, but no more than four times per year.

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- (f) In addition to the services specified in paragraph (d), medical assistance covers pediatric zirconia crowns for children.
- (f) (g) The commissioner shall not require prior authorization for the services included in paragraph (e), clauses (1) to (3), and shall prohibit managed care and county-based purchasing plans from requiring prior authorization for the services included in paragraph (e), clauses (1) to (3), when provided under sections 256B.69, 256B.692, and 256L.12.

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
