1.7	Subd. 8. Military personnel; exemption. (a) A one-day permit, An annual permit
1.8	under subdivision 4, shall 1 must be issued without a fee for a motor vehicle being used by
1.9	a person who is serving in active military service in to an inactive member of any branch
1.10	or, unit, or reserve component of the United States armed forces and who is stationed
1.11	outside Minnesota, during the period of active service and for 90 days immediately
1.12	thereafter, or state National Guard or the member's dependents if the person presents the
1.13	person's current military orders a qualifying military identification or an annual pass for
1.14	the United States military issued through the National Parks and Federal Lands Pass
1.15	Program to the park attendant on duty or other designee of the commissioner.
1.16	(b) For purposes of this section, "active service" has the meaning given under section
1.17	190.05, subdivision 5c, when performed outside Minnesota the commissioner shall
1.18	establish what constitutes a qualifying military identification by written order published
1.19	in the State Register. The written order is exempt from the rulemaking provisions of
1.20	chapter 14 and section 14.386 does not apply.

1.22	their dependents who have in their possession the annual pass for United States military
1.23	and their dependents issued by the federal government for access to federal recreation
