1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. INITIATIVE FOUNDATIONS; APPROPRIATION.
1.6	\$7,000,000 in fiscal year 2017 is appropriated from the general fund to the
1.7	commissioner of employment and economic development for grants to initiative
1.8	foundations to provide financing for business startups, expansions, and maintenance; and
1.9	for business ownership transition and succession. Of the amount appropriated:
1.10	(1) \$1,000,000 is for a grant to the Southwest Initiative Foundation;
1.11	(2) \$1,000,000 is for a grant to the West Central Initiative Foundation;
1.12	(3) \$1,000,000 is for a grant to the Southern Minnesota Initiative Foundation;
1.13	(4) \$1,000,000 is for a grant to the Northwest Minnesota Foundation;
1.14	(5) \$1,000,000 is for a grant to the Initiative Foundation;
1.15	(6) \$1,000,000 is for a grant to the Northland Foundation; and
1.16	(7) \$1,000,000 is for a grant to the Urban Initiative Board under Minnesota Statutes,
