1.11	correctional service" means service by a state employee in one of the employment positions
1.12	specified in paragraph (b) in the state-operated forensic services program or the Minnesota
1.13	Sex Offender Program if at least 75 percent of the employee's working time is spent in direct
1.14	contact with patients and the determination of this direct contact is certified to the executive
1.15	director by the commissioner of human services.

3.10	CREDIT FROM THE MSRS GENERAL PLAN.
3.11	For each employee whose employment position is music therapist and who enters the
3.12	correctional state employees retirement plan on the effective date of section 1, the executive
3.13	director must consider the employee an eligible employee under Minnesota Statutes, section
3.14	352.955, subdivision 1, paragraph (b), for purposes of Minnesota Statutes, section 352.955.
3.15	The executive director must transfer, from the general state employees retirement plan to
3.16	the correctional state employees retirement plan, any eligible prior correctional employment
3.17	as defined under Minnesota Statutes, section 352.955, subdivision 1, paragraph (c), if elected
3.18	by the eligible employee, subject to all other requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section
3.19	352.955, including payment by the eligible employee of the additional member contribution
3.20	as defined under Minnesota Statutes, section 352.955, subdivision 3, paragraph (a).
3.21	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
