1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 609.761, subdivision 3, is amended to read:
1.6	Subd. 3. Social skill game. Sections 609.755 and 609.76 do not prohibit tournaments
1.7	or contests that satisfy all of the following requirements:
1.8	(1) the tournament or contest consists of the card games of chance commonly known as
1.9	cribbage, skat, sheepshead, bridge, euchre, hasenpfeffer, pinochle, gin, 500, smear, Texas
1.10	hold'em, or whist;
1.11	(2) the tournament or contest does not provide any direct financial benefit to the promoter
1.12	or organizer;
1.13	(3) the value of all prizes awarded for each tournament or contest does not exceed \$200;

1.15	(4) for a tournament or contest involving Texas hold'em:
1.16	(i) no person under 18 years of age may participate;
1.17	(ii) the payment of an entry fee or other consideration for participating is prohibited;
1.18	(iii) the value of all prizes awarded to an individual winner of a tournament or contest
1.19	at a single location may not exceed \$200 each day; and
1.20	(iv) the organizer or promoter must ensure that reasonable accommodations are made
