1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 128C.01, subdivision 4, is amended to read:
1.6	Subd. 4. Board. (a) The league must have <u>at least a 20-member governing board.</u>
1.7	(1) The governor must appoint four members according to section 15.0597. Each of the
1.8	four appointees must be a parent. At least one of them must be an American Indian, an
1.9	Asian, a Black, or a Hispanic.
1.10	(2) The Minnesota Association of Secondary School Principals must appoint two of its
1.11	members.
1.12	(3) The remaining 14 members must be selected according to league bylaws the league's
1.13	constitution.
1.14	(b) The terms, compensation, removal of members, and the filling of membership
1.15	vacancies are governed by section 15.0575, except that the four-year terms begin on August
1.16	1 and end on July 31. As provided by section 15.0575, members who are full-time state
1.17	employees or full-time employees of school districts or other political subdivisions of the

state may not receive any per diem payment for service on the board.
