1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. OUTDOOR FIRING RANGE TRAINING FACILITY; ST. PAUL.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$4,052,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8	to the commissioner of public safety for a grant to the city of St. Paul to redevelop an existing
1.9	outdoor firing range and to remove and improve decaying facilities for law enforcement
1.10	training at the site of the existing range. This appropriation does not require a nonstate
1.11	match.
1.12	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.13	proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.14	the state in an amount up to \$4,052,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.15	prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.16	Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
1.17	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
