BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

### Section 1. EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT; TRANSFER.

The commissioner of management and budget shall transfer \$6,850,000 from the general fund to the disaster assistance contingency account, under Minnesota Statutes, section 12.221, subdivision 6. 1.10

## Sec. 2. TRANSFER OF UNEXPENDED APPROPRIATIONS.

The commissioner of management and budget may transfer any unexpended amount of the appropriations under Laws 2011, chapter 113, article 2, section 2, and Laws 2011, First Special Session chapter 7, article 10, section 5, to the disaster assistance contingency account under Minnesota Statutes, section 12.221, subdivision 6.

## Sec. 3. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; APPROPRIATION.

\$3,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of transportation in fiscal year 2015 to provide the 20 percent local match funding required to obtain Federal Highway Administration emergency relief funds to repair local roads damaged by flooding in June 2014.
