BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Subdivision 1. General education revenue. (a) For fiscal years 2013 and 2014, the general education revenue for each district equals the sum of the district's basic revenue, extended time revenue, gifted and talented revenue, small schools revenue, basic skills revenue, secondary sparsity revenue, elementary sparsity revenue, transportation sparsity revenue, total operating capital revenue, equity revenue, alternative teacher compensation

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 126C.10, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

(b) For fiscal year 2015 2016 and later, the general education revenue for each district equals the sum of the district's basic revenue, extended time revenue, gifted and talented revenue, declining enrollment revenue, local optional revenue, small schools revenue, basic skills revenue, secondary sparsity revenue, elementary sparsity revenue,

transportation sparsity revenue, total operating capital revenue, equity revenue, pension 1 16 adjustment revenue, and transition revenue.
