Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 340A.405, is amended by adding a

Subd. 7. **Growlers; off-sale.** An exclusive liquor store, with the approval of the

commissioner, may be issued an off-sale license by a municipality for off-sale of malt
- 1.9

liquor filled at the tap and packaged consistent with the requirement of section 340A.301,
- 1.10

subdivision 7, paragraph (b), by the licensee on the licensed premises. The malt liquor
- 1.11

must be made available to the licensees in kegs or barrels by a wholesaler or manufacturer
- 1.12

and be otherwise not available in Minnesota by can or bottle. All local ordinances and
- 1.13

state provisions relating to public health are applicable.
