1.1A bill for an act

1.2relating to capital investment; appropriating money for capital improvements at

1.3the Minnesota Zoological Garden; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. MINNESOTA ZOOLOGICAL GARDEN.

1.6Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$24,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds

1.7fund to the Minnesota Zoological Board for the purposes specified in this section.

1.8Subd. 2. Animal hospital renovation. \$5,000,000 of this appropriation is to design,

1.9renovate, construct, furnish, and equip the animal hospital at the Minnesota Zoological

1.10Garden.

1.11Subd. 3. Reopen the Nocturnal Trail. \$4,000,000 of this appropriation is to design,

1.12renovate, construct, furnish, and equip the closed portion of the Nocturnal Trail.

1.13Subd. 4. Asset preservation. \$15,000,000 of this appropriation is for capital asset

1.14preservation improvements and betterments to infrastructure and exhibits at the Minnesota

1.15Zoological Garden, to be spent in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 16B.307.

1.16Notwithstanding the specified uses of money under Minnesota Statutes, section 16B.307,

1.17the board may use this appropriation to replace buildings that are in poor condition, outdated,

1.18and no longer support the work of the Minnesota Zoological Garden site. A portion of this

1.19appropriation must be used to replace the Lakeside Plaza.

1.20Subd. 5. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond

1.21proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of

1.22the state in an amount up to \$24,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect

- 2.1 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 2.2 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
- 2.3 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
