Section 1. Laws 2010, chapter 207, section 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. **RICHFIELD FIREFIGHTERS; LIMITED RESPONSE TIME  
RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT.**

(a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 415.16, subdivision 2, the city of  
Richfield may impose a response time residency requirement upon firefighters under  
the following conditions:

(1) the residency requirement may not require a response time that is less than ten  
minutes;

(2) the residency requirement must only apply to firefighters hired after the effective  
date of the residency requirement; and

(3) the residency requirement must only apply during the first ten years of  
employment or until this section expires, whichever is earlier.

(b) This section expires ~~seven years from the effective date~~ December 31, 2026.
