1.6	Section 1. [124D.421] MINNESOTA TUTORING CORPS.
1.7	(a) By September 1, 2022, the commissioner of education must establish a Minnesota
1.8	tutoring corps program to provide additional instructional support to elementary, middle,
1.9	and high school students who have experienced learning loss as a result of the COVID-19
1.10	pandemic. The program must offer instructional support in all required subject areas under
1.11	section 120B.021, subdivision 1.
1.12	(b) A tutor must be:
1.13	(1) enrolled in a course under section 124D.09, subdivision 10, paragraph (b);
1.14	(2) enrolled in a bachelor's degree program related to education; or
