Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 609.487, subdivision 3, is amended to read:
Subd. 3. Fleeing officer; motor vehicle. Whoever by means of a motor vehicle flees
or attempts to flee a peace officer who is acting in the lawful discharge of an official duty,
and the perpetrator knows or should reasonably know the same to be a peace officer, is
guilty of a felony and may be sentenced as follows:
(1) if fleeing in a motor vehicle, to imprisonment for not more than three years and one
day or to payment of a fine of not more than \$5,000, or both-; or
(2) if fleeing while operating a motor vehicle in a reckless or grossly negligent manner
to imprisonment of not more than five years or to payment of a fine of not more than \$10,000
or both.
