1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 3.011, is amended to read:

1.7 **3.011 SESSIONS.**

1.8 The legislature shall meet at the seat of government on the first Tuesday after the ~~first~~

1.9 second Monday in January of each odd-numbered year. ~~When the first Monday in January~~

1.10 ~~falls on January 1, it shall meet on the first Wednesday after the first Monday.~~ It shall also

1.11 meet when called by the governor to meet in special session.

1.12 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 3.012, is amended to read:

1.13 **3.012 LEGISLATIVE DAY.**

1.14 For the purposes of article IV, section 12, of the Minnesota Constitution, a legislative

1.15 day is a day when either house of the legislature is called to order gives any bill a third

1.16 reading, adopts a rule of procedure or organization, elects a university regent, confirms a

1.17 gubernatorial appointment, or votes to override a gubernatorial veto. A legislative day begins

1.18 at seven o'clock a.m. and continues until seven o'clock a.m. of the following calendar day.
