Food stamp SNAP 1.10 1.11 households must demonstrate that: 1.12 (1) their gross income is equal to or less than 165 percent of the federal poverty guidelines for the same family size; and 1.13 1.14 (2) they meet the federal financial resource requirements under United States Code, title 7, section 2014(g), except that one licensed vehicle per household shall be excluded from 1.15 financial resource limits. 1.16 Sec. 2. REVISOR'S INSTRUCTION. 1.17 In Minnesota Statutes and Minnesota Rules, the revisor of statutes shall change the terms 1.18 "food support," "food stamp," and "food stamps" to "supplemental nutrition assistance 1.19 program" or "SNAP" when appropriate. The revisor shall make any necessary technical and 1.20 grammatical changes to preserve the meaning of the text. 1 21

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
