1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. CITY OF LINO LAKES; TAX INCREMENT FINANCING.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Duration of district. Notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota
1.7	Statutes, section 469.176, subdivision 1b, the city of Lino Lakes may collect tax
1.8	increments from tax increment financing district no. 1-10 through December 31, 2023,
1.9	subject to the conditions in subdivision 2.
1.10	Subd. 2. Conditions for extension. All tax increments remaining in the account
1.11	for the district after February 1, 2011, and all tax increments collected thereafter, must
1.12	be used only to pay debt service on bonds issued to finance the interchange of Anoka
1.13	County Highway 23 and marked Interstate Highway 35W, bonds issued to finance public
1.14	improvements serving the development known as Legacy at Woods Edge, and any bonds
1.15	issued to refund those bonds. Minnesota Statutes, sections 469.176, subdivision 4c, and
1.16	469.1763 do not apply to expenditures made under this section.
1.17	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective upon compliance by the governing
1.18	body of the city of Lino Lakes with the requirements of Minnesota Statutes, sections
1.19	469.1782, subdivision 2, and 645.021, subdivision 3.
