BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. <u>APPROPRIATION; KATHLEEN MCCULLOUGH-ZANDER</u> SUCCESS IN NURSING PROGRAM.

- (a) \$..... in fiscal year 2016 is appropriated from the general fund to the Board of Trustees of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities to implement a program to assist foreign-born students and groups underrepresented in nursing to succeed in postsecondary nursing programs. This program shall include but not be limited to mentoring programs, tutoring, and seminars.
- (b) One-half of this appropriation must be distributed to state colleges or universities located in the seven-county metropolitan area, including but not limited to Minneapolis Community and Technical College. One-half of this appropriation must be distributed to state colleges or universities located outside of the seven-county metropolitan area. The board must select state colleges or universities to participate in this program based on the proportion of enrolled nursing students that are foreign-born or from groups underrepresented in nursing.
- (c) The program established under this section shall be called the "Kathleen
 McCullough-Zander Success in Nursing Program."
