CHAPTER XXIX.—AN ACT to provide for the alteration of the St. Paul and Point Douglass Road.

Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota, That Charles R. Conway, John A. Ford, and Wm. Altenburgh be and the same are hereby appointed commissioners to examine that portion of the Point Douglass and St. Paul Road lying between St. Paul, and the dwelling House of Wm. R. Brown, and if in their opinion an alteration in the location of the same is advisable, the said Commissioners are hereby authorized to make such alteration in the location of the same as they may deem advisable. And if any alterations are made in the location of said road, the commissioners above named shall distinctly mark the same, and cause an accurate survey of the same to be made as located and marked by said commissioners, a plat of which survey shall be deposited in the office of the Register of Deeds of the county in which the alterations are made: *Provided*, That no work herein authorized shall be at the expense of the Territory.

When to meet.

SEC. 2. The Commissioners above named shall meet at the dwelling house of John A. Ford, on the second Monday of April next, and if necessary adjourn from time to time.
