CHAPTER XLIII.

An Act Describing the Great Seal of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. Adoption of the Seal heretafore used. S. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the seal heretofore used as the seal Adoption of mell of this State, shall be the seal thereof.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
