of the peace, and the said justice shall issue his warrant for the arrest of the offender, and proceed to hear and determine the matter in issue in the same manner as provided in other cases.

Repeal of former

SEC. S. Chapter one hundred and thirty of the compiled statutes of Minnesota, passed March eighth, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, and July thirtieth, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, and all other laws or parts of laws inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 9. This Act shall take effect from and after the first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and six-

ty-one.

CHAPTER LVI.

An Act for the Protection and Improvement of Sheep.

SECTION 1. Penalty for allowing buck to run at large—time when.

2. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Penalty for allowing buck to run at large time when Section 1. That if the owner of any buck shall allow the same to run at large between the first day of July and the first day of December of any year, he shall forfeit and pay the sum of ten dollars and costs of suit for each offence, to be recovered before any justice of the peace in the county where said owner shall reside, and said amount so recovered, shall be paid by the Justice to the county treasurer for the benefit of common schools.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.
