

For what purpose

expended, under the direction of said city council, in building and improving the roads leading to and from said city of Red Wing; *Provided*, The amount of tax so to be levied shall be first submitted to a vote of the electors of said city, in the manner provided in section six of an act entitled "an act to amend an act, entitled an act to incorporate the city of Red Wing," approved March fourth, eighteen hundred and fifty-seven, approved February 10th, 1860.

CHAPTER LII.

An Act to amend an act entitled "an act to incorporate the City of Rochester."

SECTION 1. Officers elected in each ward—term of office—officers to reside in their respective wards.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section three (3) of chapter two (2) of an act entitled "an act to incorporate the city of Rochester," is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Election of officers—term of office—to reside in their respective wards

Section 3. The officers elected in each ward shall be two aldermen, one assessor, one justice of the peace, and one constable, who shall hold their offices for two years and until their successors are elected and qualified, (except as hereinafter provided,) except the constable, whose term of office shall be one year. All of which officers shall be residents of the wards in which they are elected, and shall have resided therein thirty days, and in the city six months next preceding such election; and all city officers shall be qualified electors of the State.

And it is further provided, That at the next annual election of said city, the said aldermen in each ward shall

be elected as follows: One alderman in each ward for the term of one year, and one alderman for two years; and there shall be elected annually thereafter one alderman for each ward.

CHAPTER LIII.

An Act to Repeal the Charter of the City of Shakopee.

- SECTION 1. Repeal of the act to incorporate the city of Shakopee.
 2. What streets to be declared public highways.
 3. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That an act entitled "an act to incorporate the city of Shakopee," approved May twenty-third, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven, and all acts and parts of acts amendatory thereto, be and the same are hereby repealed; *Provided*, That the whole of section number one, in township number one hundred and fifteen north, of range twenty-three west, and the west half of section number six, in township one hundred and fifteen north, of range twenty-two west, shall hereafter be and constitute a part of the county of Scott, as heretofore.

SEC. 2. The several streets and alleys and the levee in the recorded plat of said city of Shakopee are hereby declared to be public highways, and all general laws of the State of Minnesota relating to the improvement, repair and regulation of roads and highways, shall apply to said streets, alleys and levee.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force on the first day of October, A. D. 1861.
