## CHAPTER LXXVIII.

### *An Act to Authorize the Commissioners of Ramsey County to issue a Duplicate Bond.*

**SHERRIS** 1. Commissioners authorized to issue duplicate bond—to whom—when. May require bond of indemnity.  
2. Act, when to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

**SECTION 1.** That the board of commissioners of Ramsey county are authorized to issue to Thompson Brothers, of St. Paul, a duplicate of bond number two hundred and eighty-two (282), upon satisfactory evidence being adduced to the commissioners that said original bond has been lost or destroyed, anything in the act entitled "an act to authorize the commissioners of Ramsey county to issue bonds," approved March sixth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty, to the contrary notwithstanding.

*Provided,* That before issuing said duplicate bond, said commissioners may require a bond of indemnity, so as to protect the county against said original bond.

**SEC. 2.** This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
