

CHAPTER XXVI.

An Act prescribing the duties of the Supreme Court, in certain cases.

- SECTION 1. Duties of the Judges of the Supreme Court.
 2. Duty of Clerk of Supreme Court.
 3. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That it shall be the duty of the judges of the supreme court of this State, respectively, at the time of announcing the decision in each and every action then pending in said court, to file with the clerk thereof, a syllabus of the decision in such actions, so prepared as to embody as briefly as practicable, the principles settled in and by such decision. Duties of Judges

SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of the clerk of said court, immediately thereafter, to make and furnish to the publishers of each of the daily papers in the city of St. Paul, who shall consent to publish the same without charge, a copy of each syllabus so filed as aforesaid, accompanied with the title of the action. Duty of Clerk

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
