

CHAPTER XXXIV.

An Act to amend Section Thirty-two of Chapter Seventeen, of the Compiled Statutes, relating to Religious Societies.

SECTION 1. Amendment to section 32. District Court to make transfer of real estate.
2. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section thirty-two, of chapter seventeen, of the compiled Statutes, be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 32. That when any real estate shall have or may be hereafter bequeathed, purchased, donated or otherwise entrusted to any religious society or corporation in this State, or to any of the trustees or officers of any of such society or corporation for the use and benefit of such society or corporation, or for any other purpose, and such society or religious corporation shall be desirous to sell, exchange, or in any manner to convey or incumber, or otherwise dispose of such real estate by deed, mortgage or other conveyance, it shall be lawful for the district court of the county where such real estate is situate, upon good cause shown, upon application of such society or religious corporation, or of some person authorized by them, to make an order authorizing the sale or incumbrance or other disposition or transfer of any such real estate as desired by such society or religious corporation. And the court may in such order, direct the application of the proceeds (if any there be,) of such sale or incumbrance. *Provided*, That such order be not inconsistent with the original terms upon which such real estate became invested in or entrusted to such religious society or corporation.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
