## CHAPTER LXXXI.

An Act to Change the name of Charles Edward Bedbury, to that of Charles Edwin Gillett.

SECTION 1. Change of name.
2. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the name of Charles Edward Bedbury, now of Belle Plaine, Scott county in this State, be and the same is hereby changed and declared to be Charles Edwin Gillett.
