An Act relating to Burying Grounds.

SECTION 1. Relating to the title of burial lots.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Relating to the
title of burial
lots.

SECTION 1. The title to every lot or piece of land which shall have been used by the inhabitants of any town or village in this state as a cemetery or public burying ground for the space of ten years, shall be deemed vested in such town or village and shall be subject in the same manner as other corporate property of towns or villages to the government and direction of the same: provided, nothing herein contained be construed to apply to any lot or piece of ground used as a burying ground, the title to which is vested by deed or otherwise in any cemetery association: provided also, that the provisions of this act shall not apply to or in any way effect the title to any tract or parcel of land now or hereafter [heretofore] occupied for a burying ground, situated or lying within the corporate limits of the city of Stillwater.

When act to
take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
