CHAPTER XXXIV.

March 1, 1872. An Act relative to the appointment of Township Assessors.

SECTION 1. Relating to the appointment of township assessors.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

County auditor to appoint assessors, when. Section 1. When any township assessor is elected and fails or refuses to qualify to discharge the duties of his office, or if the electors of said township fail, from any reason whatever, to elect an assessor, and the town board of said township fails or refuses to appoint an assessor for said township on or before the first day of June of that year for which said assessor is to serve, then it shall be the duty of the county auditor to appoint an assessor for said township, who shall be a resident of said county.

When act to take effect.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
