## CHAPTER XLV.

March 4, 1872.

An Act fixing the time of holding the General Terms of Court in the counties of Winona, Houston and Olmsted, in the third Judicial District.

Section 1. General terms of district court in Winona, Olmsted and Houston counties.

- 2. All proceedings heretofore had returnable to the terms herein established-
- 3. Repeal of inconsistent acts.
- 4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Terms of court in Winona county, Houston county, Olmsted county. Section 1. The general terms of the district court in and for the counties of Winona, Houston and Olmsted in the third judicial district shall be held at the times following:

In the county of Winona on the first Monday in April and the first Monday in September in each year. In the county of Houston on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in May, and the first Tuesday after the fourth Monday in October in each year. In the county of Olmsted on the first Monday in March and the first Monday in October in each year.

All proceedings returnable to this term.

Sec. 2. All process, writs, bonds, continuances, appeals, notices, proceedings and recognizances, issued, made or returnable to the terms of court in and for each of said counties as fixed by law prior to the passage of this act, shall be deemed and construed as made, taken and returnable to the terms of court in and for said counties respectively as fixed by this act.

Sec. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
