## CHAPTER XLVI.

An Act to fix the times of holding Court in the Fifth Judicial District.

February $27_{T}$ 1872

Section 1. Toms of court in the Fifth Judicial District.
2. All proceedings heretofore had returnable to the terms asilhercin estabfished.
3. Repeal of section 29 of chapter 64 of the general statutes.
4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
Section 1. The general terms of the district court of the fifth judicial district of this state, shall be held annually at the times and places as follows, to wit:

In the county of Dodge on the first Monday in March and the first Tuesday in September. In the county of Mower on the third Tuesday in March and the third Tuesday in September. In the county of Rice on the first Tuesday in May and the first Tuesday in October. In the county of Steele on the first Tuesday in June and the first Tuesday in December. In the county of Freeborn on the third Tuesday in June and the third Tuesday in November. In the county of Waseca on the second Tuesday in February and the third Tuesday. in October.

Sec. 2. All writs, recognizances, and all other papers and proceedings made returnable to the district court of the said several counties, shall be considered and deemed to be returnable to the terms of said court as the same are fixed by this act, and all continuances, appeals, motions, notices, or other proceedings taken or made to or for any term of said court, shall be considered and construed to be made or taken to the terms of said court as fixed by this act.

Sec. 3. Section twenty-nine of chapter sixty-four of the general statutes, and all acts and parts of acts amendatory thereof and inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
