An Act to amend an Act to prescribe the times for General Terms of the District Court in the several counties constituting the Seventh Judicial District. Approved March 6, 1871.

Section 1. Amendment to section 1 of chapter 74 of the general laws of 1872. Section 1. General terms of the district court in the Seventh Judicial District.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Section one of chapter seventy-four of the general laws of 1871, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

That the general terms of the district court in the seventh judicial district shall be held in the several counties in said

district at the times hereinafter prescribed, to wit:

Torm of court in Sherburne, Stearns, Douglas, Pope, Morrison, Crow Wing, Otter Tail, Becker, Benton, St. Louis, Mille Lacs counties.

In the county of Sherburne on the second Tuesday of February in each year. In the county of Stearns on the second Tuesday of June and the first Tuesday of December in each year. In the county of Douglas on the first Tuesday of October in each year. In the county of Pope on the second Tuesday of October in each year. In the county of Morrison on the third Tuesday of October in each year. In the county of Crow Wing on the fourth Tuesday of October in each year. In the county of Otter Tail on the third Tuesday of November in each year. In the county of Becker on the second Tuesday of November in each year. In the county of Benton on the last Tuesday of November in each year. In the county of St. Louis on the second Tuesday of August and the third Tuesday of February in each year. In the county of Mille Lacs on the last Tuesday in September in each year.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.
