

CHAPTER VI.

*An Act to amend section 2 of chapter 5 of General Laws of 1870; being an Act entitled "An act to define the duties of County Superintendents of Schools."*

- SECTION 1. Amendment to section two of chapter five of General Laws of 1870.
- 2. Abstract of the number of persons in each school district to be filed before the last Wednesday of October.
- 3. Repeal of acts inconsistent herewith.
- 4. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 5 of general laws of 1870, being an act entitled an act to define the duties of county superintendents of schools, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows :

Amendment to section 2, chapter 5, general laws of 1870.

Sec. 2. It shall be the duty of the county superintendent of schools, on the day before the last Wednesday of October of each year, to file with the county auditor an abstract of the number of persons in each school district in his county, between the ages of five and twenty-one years, which number shall be made the basis for the apportionment of the school money for that school year, and also of the number of months of school taught in each district by a legally qualified teacher, as shown by the annual report of school district clerks, legally made to him for the school year ending September 30th, last past.

County superintendent to file abstract of school children

SEC. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

Repeal of inconsistent acts

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
