other papers relating to the action, and filed with the justice, and upon the filing of his return the district court shall become possessed of the action and shall proceed therein in the same manner as near as may be as in actions originally commenced in that court except as herein otherwise provided.

When act to take effect.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER LXVII.

March 1, 1872.

An Act to amend Section Thirty-Four of Chapter Sixty-Five of the General Statutes relating to adjournments in Justices' Courts.

SECTION 1. Repeal of part of section 34 of chapter 64 of the general statutes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Sec. 1. All that part of sec. 34, of chapter 65 of the general statutes relating to adjournments in justice's court, after the word "days" in the 6th line of the section is stricken out.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and atter its passage.
