

First city elec-

SEC. 3. That the said judge of probate in his order designating the time and place of holding the first election of officers of any city incorporated under this act shall name three electors of each ward who shall conduct the said first election for their respective wards and who shall be the inspectors thereof and shall take the usual oath or affirmation as prescribed by the general laws of the state to be taken by the judges and inspectors of elections, and shall have the power to appoint clerks of such elections, and to administer the necessary oaths, and the persons so named as inspectors of the election shall hold and conduct the same in the manner and under the same penalties as provided by the laws of this state regarding elections, and shall have power to fill vacancies in the board of inspectors as provided by law.

*An Act to amend Section Nine of Chapter Thirty-Three
of the General Laws of 1871.*

- SECTION 1. Amendment to section 9 of chapter 33 of the general laws of 1871.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section nine of chapter thirty-three of the general laws of 1871 be amended by inserting the words "and Root" after the word St. Croix and before the word rivers in the tenth line of said section.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
