

CHAPTER CCVI.

1872.

An Act to authorize the return of Land Road Warrants, in the town of Aurora, and the levy and collection of the unpaid taxes therein mentioned.

- SECTION 1. Land road warrants to be returned to county auditor for extension of taxes.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Land road warrants to be returned.

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the several overseers of highways in the town of Aurora, in the county of Steele, within ten days after the passage of this act, (if they have not so done before,) to return to the county auditor of said county, the land road warrants placed in their hands by the supervisors of said town, for the year 1871, with a proper return thereon showing what taxes have been paid, and what taxes have not been paid.

And it shall be the duty of the county auditor, immediately after such returns, to levy and extend the unpaid taxes in said warrants upon the tax books and records in his office, and the same shall be collected and enforced in the same manner as other taxes for said year.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
