

sixty, or of the bonds bearing not less than six per cent. interest of the states of Massachusetts, New York, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, Michigan, Missouri and Iowa.

Sec. 2. There is hereby annually appropriated such sums as shall be found necessary for expenses of purchase, and payment of accrued interest at time of purchase, of bonds for permanent school and university funds, payable from general school and university funds, and for expenses and accrued interest of bonds purchased for other funds named in the first section of this act, payable from the funds for which such purchases are made.

Appropriation of funds, for what purpose.

Sec. 3. Chapter one hundred and six of the general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, is hereby repealed.

Repeal of former act.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.

## CHAPTER CVI.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSIONER OF THE STATE LAND OFFICE TO ISSUE NEW CERTIFICATES OF PURCHASE, IN CERTAIN CASES.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That whenever the holder of any certificate of purchase of any state or school lands shall surrender the same to the commissioner of the state land office, with a request to have the same divided into two or more certificates, it shall be lawful for said commissioner to issue the same; *Provided*, That if the applicant shall desire new certificates, dividing said land by boundaries other than regular government or state subdivisions, the applicant shall file with his application a plat and survey, showing the lines of the division desired, and the quantity of land in each subdivision; *Provided*, That no new certificate shall issue while there is due and unpaid any interest; nor in any case where said commissioner shall be of opinion that the security of the state would be impaired and endangered.

When land commissioner to issue new certificates of purchase—when not to issue.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.
