CHAPTER CX.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER THIRTY-ONE OF THE GEN-ERAL STATUTES OF MINNESOTA, RELATING TO DAMS AND MILLS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section twelve of chapter thirty-one of the general statutes of Minnesota, be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 12. The appellant shall file with the clerk aforesaid, a bond, with security, to be approved by the judge of said court, and in such sum as said judge shall determine, payable to the Bond on appeal, state of Minnesota, for the use of all persons interested, in which bond the proceeding appealed from shall be briefly recited, with condition for the due and speedy prosecution of the appeal, and that appellant will abide the order or judgment of the court, and pay the costs of appeal, if adjudged so to do by the court in reference to the matter in controversy; and this section shall apply to cases now commenced and pending under this chapter, where no appeal has been perfected, as well as to future cases.

> SEC. 2. Section fifteen of said chapter thirty-one is amended by adding at the end thereof the following: "And unless the petitioner shall pay such assessment and cost within sixty days after entry of judgment, he shall forfeit all right under his proceeding; and no possession, use or occupancy of the premises described and attempted to be taken under the provisions of this act, shall be permitted until payment is made as herein specified."

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
