CHAPTER CXXX.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE OF CHAPTER TWENTY-SIX OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF THE YEAR A. D. EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THREE, RELATING TO LAKES WACONIA AND MINNETONKA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section one of chapter twenty-six of the general laws of the year A. D. eighteen hundred and seventy-three be, and the same hereby is amended so as to read as follows ;

Sec. 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to catch, kill, or destroy, in any manner otherwise than with hook and line, any fish known by the name of pike, pickerel or bass, from either of the lakes of Waconia or Minnetonka, in the county of Carver, or from any inlet or outlet of either of said lakes, situate and being in said Carver county, between the fifteenth day of March and the fifteenth day of May, in any year. Unlawful to take what fish and when.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

CHAPTER CXXXI.

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE CATCHING OF FISH IN FREEBORN LAKE, IN FREEBORN COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to catch fish in Freeborn lake, in Freeborn county, Minnesota, with a spear, between the first day of November and the first day of May of each year. When not to catch fish with a spear.
